



2018 CARRICK UNRAVELLED PINOT NOIR

Carrick Bannockburn Vineyard, SWNZ BIOGRO-5056

Carrick Unravelled is our early drinking offering for Pinot Noir lovers. The name references the Carrick Bend our symbol of the people and land, here it is a metaphor for the more relaxed style of this wine.

The vineyard is tended by hand, allowing for careful management of individual vines, throughout the season. Each parcel is fermented separately in open top fermenters and undergoes wild, indigenous yeast, spontaneous ferments. It is a premium wine made from predominantly Dijon clones on various rootstocks, from vines planted in 1996.

Hand-picked in: March 2018

Bottled: January 2019

Cases: 6500 x 6 bottle cases

Matured in French oak barrique for 8 months, with 9% new oak, the Unravelled is light-bodied and finely structured. The 2018 has lovely flow, with cherry and black plum notes, as well as some subtle spice. We enjoy this as our day to day dinner wine.

Organically certified since 2008, to EU equivalence.
